Figure S1 Genetic characterisation of the der(2)t(1;2)(q12;p13) in CH1 lymphoma B cells. (A) Agilent 244K CGH-array profile of the 2p breakpoint region. Genomic coordinates and BAC clones mapping to the region are indicated. The t(1;2) breakpoint (bk) is represented by the dashed horizontal line. 2p regions in 2 (2N) or 3 (3N) copies are indicated. (B) Confirmation of the breakpoint region by dual colour FISH and identification of a 'mirror image' 2p duplication on the der(2) chromosome, using 2p BAC probes, as indicated.

Figure S2 3D-FISH characterisation of aHCF positive and negative human lymphoma B cells. (A) 3D immuno-FISH showing colocalisation between 1q12 satellite DNA (red) and foci enriched in H3K9me3 (green) (white arrows), in CH1 cells; DNA is counterstained with DAPI (blue). (B) 3D FISH analyses in human lymphoma B cells that do not harbour 1q12 pericentric heterochromatin ; 1q12 (green signals), chromosome 2 centromere (red signals). Note the absence of aHCF.

Figure S3 Model showing how aberrant heterochromatic foci might form as a consequence of long range intrachromosomal interactions between translocated 1q12 and chromosome 2 centromeric regions, in CH1 lymphoma B cell interphase nuclei. The nuclear organisation of the 2p arm is not known but for simplicity is presented as a single large loop displaced away from the aHCF.

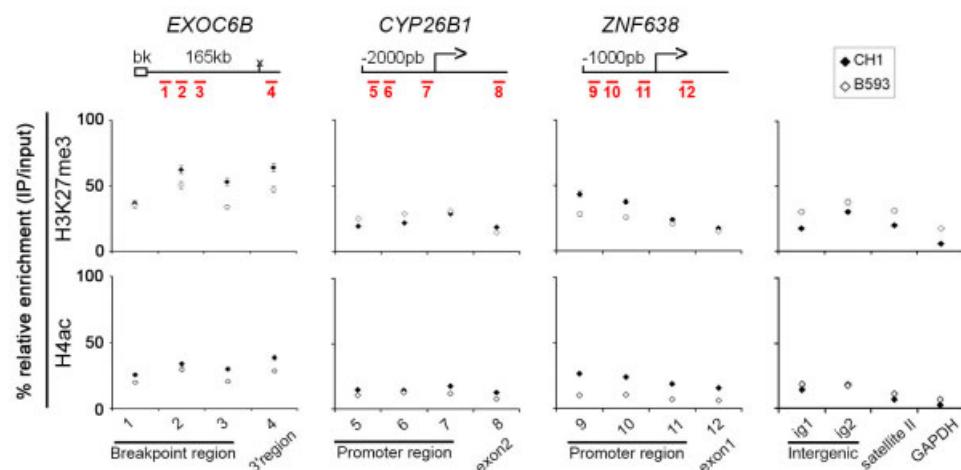
