



**Figure SI-1.** Variation of the zero-shear viscosity with the polymer concentration for solutions of initial HA-200, HA-pentenoate with DS = 20 and 50 %, HA-MPA prepared in water and in water/IPA with DS = 18 % in PBS at 25 °C.



**Figure SI-2.**  $^1\text{H}$  NMR spectrum (400 MHz, 80 °C, 6 mg/mL in  $\text{D}_2\text{O}$ ) of HA-pentenoate-GRGD-200 prepared from HA-pentenoate with DS = 20 %. Digital integration of the NMR signals arising from the  $\text{Hd}'$  and  $\text{H1}$  protons and those located at 3.1 ppm as well as in the 1.5–2 region gives a substitution degree of 5 % for the GRGD peptide.
