


Supplementary figure 1: scatter plot of the 135 tumors according to the two items of the G2I showing the relatively high frequency of G2I-3 tumors without axillary lymph node involvement in comparison to the G2I-2 tumors (20/28 versus 43/88)

Supplementary figure 2: Frequency plot of copy number alterations in tumors belonging to the three classes of the G2I. Plot D shows the specificity of the numerous losses of material observed with a high frequency in G2I-3 tumors (in green in this plot).



Supplementary figure 3: supervised hierarchical clustering showing the differential expression of 300 probe sets (listed in sup. table 9) between G2I-3 and G2I-2 tumors.
