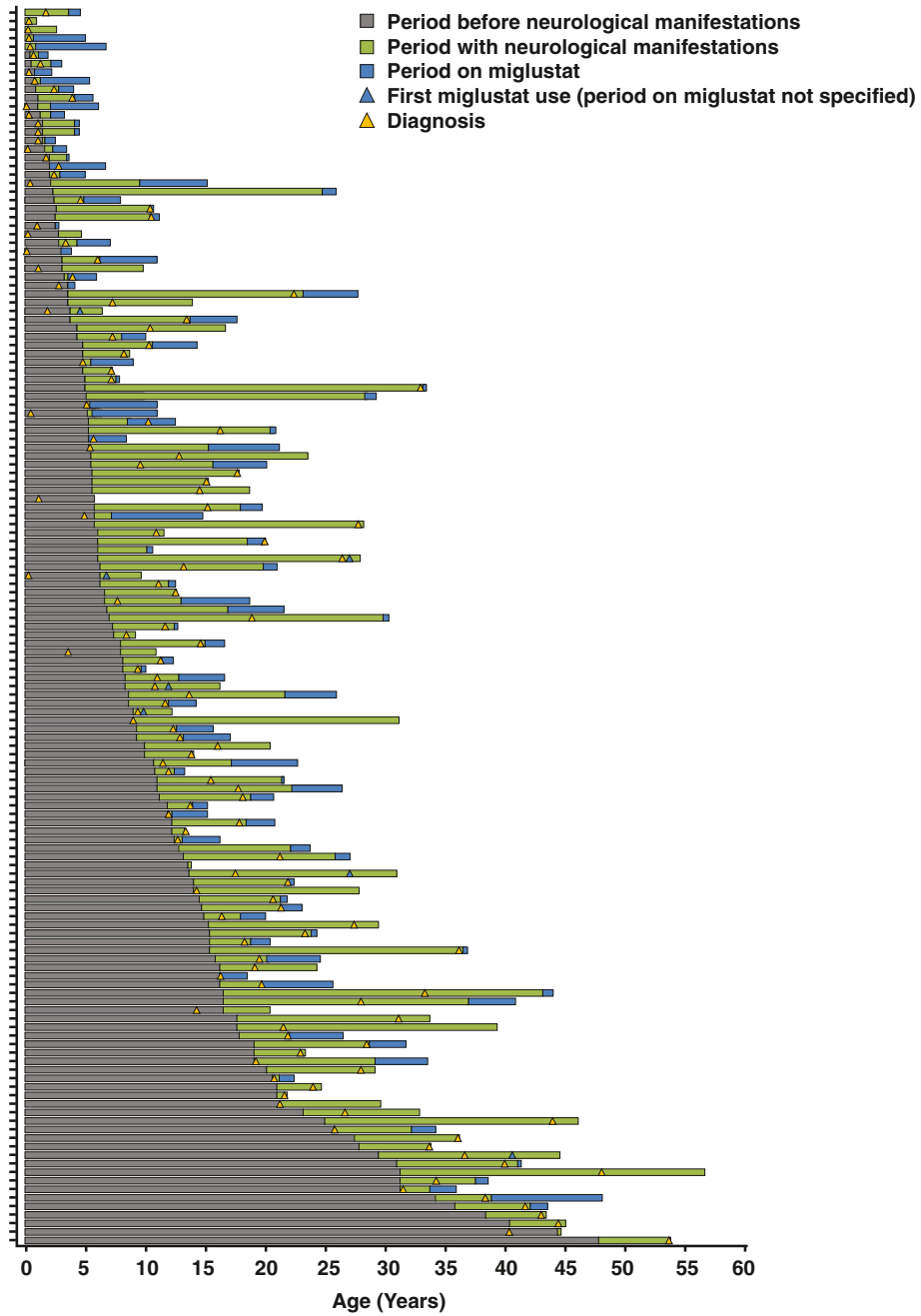


Figure 1 Overview of patient and disease characteristics. We regret any inconvenience that this inaccuracy may have caused.
