
EXAMPLE AND DEFINITIONS

Example

In this example, we are asked to anticipate the risk of death from HCC during the coming year for a man, 20 years old, who was diagnosed with a compensated cirrhosis 1 year before... >>>>



<u>Definitions</u>:

<u>First decompensation</u>: means the first decompensation episode (ascites, digestive hemorrhage, encephalopathy, icterus)

Stable decompensated state: means the patient has a history of a first decompensation, but after the first one he doesn't do any other decompensation episode

<u>Progressive decompensated state</u>: means the patient has successive decompensation episodes

HCC: hepatocellular carcinoma
