




* First decompensation: means the first decompensation episode (ascites, digestive hemorrhage, encephalopathy, icterus)

STABLE DECOMPENSATED STATE*




* Stable decompensated state: means the patient has a history of first decompensation, but afterwards no further decompensation episode

PROGRESSIVE DECOMPENSATED STATE*




* Progressive decompensated state: means the patient has successive decompensation episodes






FIRST DECOMPENSATION*




* First decompensation: means the first decompensation episode (ascites, digestive hemorrhage, encephalopathy, icterus)

STABLE DECOMPENSATED STATE*




* Stable decompensated state: means the patient has a history of first decompensation, but afterwards no further decompensation episode
